State agencies will further allocate other funds contained in the General Appropriations Act based on their own authorized distribution methodologies. The FEFP and funds distributed to counties by state agencies are not identified in this report.

This report was produced prior to the veto process; the items contained herein are authorized by the Legislature, but still not officially approved by the Governor.
