Re: Red Clay on Pensacola Beach Roadway Improvement Project Our Project Number 21201.16

Dear Board Members:

I have been informed of a position put forth that the Roadway Improvement contractor for Via DeLuna – Roads, Inc. – is bringing prohibited materials onto Pensacola Beach to use in the construction of the roadway base course. This is not correct.

Roads, Inc. has removed over 35,000 cubic yards of prohibited material from Via DeLuna in the course of this project – over 1,900 truckloads of material have left Pensacola Beach.

Baskerville-Donovan, Inc. has a project representative on-site to ensure the contractor does not bring prohibited material to the project site. Roads, Inc. is complying with the County ordinance 12.05.04 regarding red clay or other prohibited materials. When found, prohibited materials are removed to a depth of 24 inches below the plane of the land surface, contained, and covered.

We will continue to direct the contractor to remove prohibited materials from Pensacola Beach at every opportunity in accordance with the County ordinance. As Buck has stated correctly, Roads, Inc. may not get every grain, but they are removing a very large amount of prohibited materials from the beach.
