[ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

Santa Rosa County Sheriff's Office was contacted by the Department of Children and Families concerning allegations of neglect concerning a child, a white male, currently age four. The child was admitted to Sacred Heart Hospital on March 12th, 2008. He was admitted to the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit.

On admission, body temperature was 91.1 degrees Fahrenheit, he had a blood sugar level of 4mG/DL. (The normal range for this test is 60-105). was also according to medical records, dehydrated. According to medical records, was on various anti-convulsive medications and blood tests taken on admission showed no detectable level of these medications in his blood.

Areas of skin are breaking down resulting in bed sores.

On March 17th, 2008, was interviewed by DCF Investigator and your affiant. During this interview, Markes stated she is the primary care giver for. She reported that she bathes and feeds. She acknowledged missing medical appointments for but blamed the physicians for not telling her about the appointments. Markes stated that she gave his anti-seizure medication two times a day as directed and could not account for the medication not being detected in's blood work on admission to Sacred Heart Hospital. Markes stated that she felt she has not been doing her best in caring for in the past weeks. She recalled seeing one area on

his buttocks breaking down but denied seeing any other locations.

An assessment was done by Dr. Thomas G. Mignerey, MD, a Child Protection Team Pediatrician. Dr. Mignerey states in his report that "six months ago he weighed 6.9 kilograms with well documented weight of 8.2 kilograms two years ago. It would appear that he has been somewhat lost to follow up. He came to the pediatric clinic one month ago as parent sought a new primary care physician. This was on 2/12/08. His weight at that time was 5.835 kilograms and the child is now admitted at 5.6 kilograms. The child therefore has lost nearly six pounds in the last two years despite the fact the child has a feeding tube and is apparently able to take some oral feedings. The child also comes into the hospital on this occasion with fairly impressive decubiti over the sacral bony prominences. The child is on a number of medications including [REDACTED]. The child is supposedly getting Pedia Sure by mouth and/or a PE tube but at this point it is very clear and obvious that the child is not coming close to adequate nutrition at home".

Dr. Mignerey continues in his report "this infant is unbelievably cachectic. I am not sure I have seen a child this cachectic ever before in 30 years. There is no fat tissue. It is skin lying directly on bone structure with almost no visible muscle tissue present either".

**ASSESSMENT:** Severe Cachexia-emaciation with bed sores secondary to utter neglect of calories and skin care at home.

It should be noted that [REDACTED] has a diagnosis of [REDACTED]. His development is severely delayed.

Sacred Heart medical staff advised they do not expect [REDACTED] to survive this hospitalization. They believe this is the inevitable consequence of his medical diagnosis.

Your affiant believes that reasonable grounds exist to believe that Erin Markes, DOB 10/28/88, committed the offense of child neglect, violation of Florida Statute 827.03(3)2b. Your affiant requests a warrant be issued for the arrest of Erin Markes on the above charges which occurred at 4945 Andrea Lane, Pace, Santa Rosa County, Florida.

On March 14th, 2008, Protective Investigator [REDACTED] met with [REDACTED] and provided medical records concerning [REDACTED], the victim in this case. These records have been preserved in the case file. [REDACTED] also provided disks containing color photographs of the victim photographed at Sacred Heart Hospital by the Child Protection Team. This disk has been preserved in the case file.

[REDACTED] reported the victim had been the topic of an investigation by the Saline County Sheriff's Office in Missouri. [REDACTED] contacted the Saline County Sheriff's Office and requested a search of their records for information concerning [REDACTED]. It was learned that there was no record at Saline County. [REDACTED] contacted the Marshall PD in Marshall, Missouri. [REDACTED] spoke to [REDACTED] who searched records and found a report concerning [REDACTED]. This report consisting of six pages was faxed to [REDACTED]. This report was dated 12/14/2006 and was an endangering the welfare of a child report. This report has been preserved in the case file.

It was learned that [REDACTED] was currently a patient in the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit

at Sacred Heart Hospital. According to DCF personnel, Jaden weighed eleven pounds and is currently age four.

On March 17th, 2008 [REDACTED] met Protective Investigator [REDACTED] at the DCF office in Milton, Florida. Shortly afterwards, Erin Markes, DOB 10/23/88 arrived at [REDACTED] office. Following introductions, Marks was advised that she was not under arrest and free to leave at any time. Markes reported that she lives at 4945 Andrea Lane in Pace, Florida. Markes says she has lived there since June 22nd, 2007.

Markes said she lives with her "step-father" [REDACTED], [REDACTED]

During the interview, Markes was asked the last time [REDACTED] had seen a physician. She reported that [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] at the Sacred Heart Hospital Pediatric Clinic. When asked about his prior visit, Markes said [REDACTED] saw [REDACTED] at the end of September. She stated he had not seen a doctor from September until February of 08. Markes provided a list of drugs which [REDACTED] takes. She reported she has these prescriptions filled at Walgreen's in Pace or at the Walgreen's at Olive Road and Davis Highway. Markes said that she is the primary caretaker. Markes said that occasionally [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] care for [REDACTED] when she goes out to eat or to a movie. Markes stated "I came to realize this past week, I can't do it all on my own".

Markes was asked if [REDACTED] received his medications at the required times. She reported that he always receives his medications except on the occasions that she oversleeps and then she gives it when she wakes up.

Erin Markes was asked about the condition of [REDACTED]'s skin and the breakdowns observed in the photographs. Markes was shown one of the photographs showing her son and the reddened areas breaking down on his back and buttocks areas. Markes says that she saw them and that she may have missed some of them. Markes was asked if she had been neglectful in her care of [REDACTED]. She said "I feel I wasn't doing my best". She added "he needs more than I can give him".

Markes said that she receives \$634.00 a month from the Social Security benefits for [REDACTED] and that she does babysitting which generates \$100.00 - \$200.00 per week in income. Markes stated that her son receives Medicaid benefits and that they have been in effect. Markes acknowledged missing doctors appointments at CMS at Sacred Heart and stated these appointments were missed because no one told her about them.

This interview was recorded in its entirety and Markes swore to the accuracy of its contents at the conclusion.
