Yes I got the fax and I have not wasted any time getting started. I have spoken with Gene Valentino and tentatively scheduled a background briefing with him in the next few days.

I have done some research into machines, other parlors, tribal rights and pros/cons (which is how I found the article on Bingolingo.com about Florida being the best place for bingo.) I prepared for and attended the DRC meeting yesterday and spoke in support of the permit. I left with a phone list of all the attendees at that meeting (for later use). I've been quoted in the newspaper and have maintained support on Pensacola News Journal Blogs for the project (as ProPerdido) and defended myself personally (as BBinPerdido) and just a few moments ago...I was contacted by and recorded a telephone interview with WUWF radio 88.1FM that went very well. I have the Chamber of Commerce requesting letters of support from visitors and members that don't hesitate to voice their positive opinions and I will use it to compile a file of ammunition for Gene Valentino and a data base of contacts for us to use in the future.

I have not disclosed publically (and to very few personally) that I am directly involved with the project or developers. For now, it would be most effective to keep it that way. I need some time to spend

talking with you about some of the next steps we need to take. I need contact information for the other key people you think can help bring me up to20speed on the project details. And I need your approval to spend time and money developing a grass roots website of our own that has a supportinve slant.
