THIS CAUSE having come before this Court upon the Plaintiff's Motion for Default Judgment, and the Court having heard argument of counsel and it appearing to the Court that no responsive pleadings were filed by Defendants, RONALD L. PHILLIPS, PATRICIA A. PHILLIPS, and BEACH AUTOS, INC., and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

judgment creditor is not represented by an attorney, within 45 days from the date of this final judgment, unless the final judgment is satisfied or post-judgment discovery is stayed.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained to enter further orders to include but not limited to those orders that are proper to compel the judgment debtor(s) to complete form 1.977, including all required attachments, and serve it on the judgment creditor's attorney, or the judgment creditor if the judgment creditor is not represented by an attorney.
