## [ STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE ]

On 11/22/2012 in Escambia County, Florida, Antonia Bennett did knowingly and intentionally commit the offenses of Trespass After Warning, Disorderly Conduct, and Resisting Arrest Without Violence at the Walmart on Blue Angel Parkway, as follows:

On 11/22/2012 I was working off duty security at the Walmart on Blue Angel Parkway. Also working was Deputy Mann #318. While patrolling the store, Deputy Mann was notified of an incident occurring in the Grocery Side Action Alley involving two females who were fighting over a cell phone which did not go on sale until 2200 hours. Upon Deputy Mann's arrival in the area, he was informed that a black female had taken three TracFones out of a sales display case which was not to be opened until 2200 hours. When the female was confronted by several other patrons who were patiently waiting in line, she began cussing and screaming at the people, causing a disturbance.

## ARREST REPORT

Deputy Mann was able to locate the female and she was identified as S/Antonia Bennett by her Florida driver's license. He then escorted her up to the front to explain to her that the phone was not to be out of the display until 2200 hours. When they arrived where I was located at the front door, Deputy Mann recovered one of the cell phones, which was the only one in her possession at the time; at which time S/Bennett began yelling and screaming and causing a scene at the door. S/Bennett refused to listen to what was being instructed to her and continued to raise her voice, causing patrons who were entering and exiting the Walmart to stop and gather round. At this point, I informed S/Bennett that she needed to calm down and be quiet and listen to what we were trying to tell her, but she refused and continued to get louder and louder. I, again, told her that she needed to calm down and listen or I would have no choice but to trespass her and have her leave for the night. Again, she raised her voice and started yelling at me, saying the only reason I was doing this was because she was black. At this point, I told her that she needed to shut up and listen to me or I would have no choice but to trespass her. Again, she told me no and continued screaming. I then told her I was done with this argument with her and that she needed to take her child, who was asleep in the basket, and leave the store and not come back for the night. She looked right at me and stated no. I then informed her that if she did not leave while being ordered to do so by an officer, she would be arrested for Disorderly Conduct and Trespass After Warning. She then informed me that I could not make her leave; that she was doing nothing wrong.

At this point, after warning her several times, I then informed S/Bennett she was under arrest and she needed to place her hands behind her back, which she refused to do. I then gave her verbal commands, again, to place her hands behind her back because she was under arrest at which time she grabbed the buggy with both hands and refused to let go. I then placed my handcuffs on her left wrist and was able to break it free from the buggy. I was unable to break her right hand free from the buggy, so I gave three strikes to her right forearm, causing her hand to release from the buggy. I then took S/Bennett to a gaited wall, then to the ground, where she continued to struggle until I was finally able to grab a hold of her right wrist and place the cuffs on her. After placing the cuffs on her she continued to struggle and I had to forcibly escort her out the door to my patrol car. Upon placing her into the back of my patrol car, she again stated that the only reason I was doing this was because I was white, she was black, and President Obama was black. I then informed her that the only reason she was arrested was because she refused to listen and leave when ordered to do so. Due to the fact that she had a small child with her, her husband was contacted and responded to the Walmart to retrieve the child.

It should be noted due to the fact that force was used to place S/Bennett under arrest, I contacted Sergeant Nelson #108 and he responded to the scene. It should be noted that there was video of the incident which Sergeant Nelson retrieved. It should also be noted that while this incident occurred, there was a white male, who was later identified as W/ [REDACTED] who was standing there and witnessed the whole incident.


S/Bennett was transported to the Escambia County Jail for processing, given a County Court date of 12/13/2012, and a \$1,500 bond.

It should be noted that after the use of force on S/Bennett, she did not complain of any injury and needed no medical treatment.

It should also be noted that a Blue Team Form was completed in reference to this incident.


