3/15/13- I received a call from Ed Spears (CMPA) and Mandy Bills of the City of Pensacola relative to our "public records request" for information pertinent to the Community Maritime Park (CMP) complex. Mr. Spears expressed concern about the volume of work required to comply with our request.
