Marsh have made on oath that during the period of January 2013 to June 2014 in the County of Escambia aforesaid one Christopher David Fowler did unlawfully violate Florida Statute 1008.24 contrary to the law in such case and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Florida.

This Warrant is a command to arrest instanter the above named Christopher David Fowler and bring said person before the court to be dealt with according to law.

The Office of the State Attorney (OSA), 1<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit and Escambia County School District (ECSD) have conducted a joint investigation beginning on March 30, 2015. Chief Investigator Randy Crowder and Investigator Gary Marsh conducted the investigation. Crowder, as Chief Investigator for the OSA, has more than 21 years of law enforcement experience investigating crimes of corruption, fraud, theft, loan sharking, money laundering, prostitution, securities fraud, racketeering and other white collar crimes. Marsh, as Investigator for the ECSD, has more than 30 years of law enforcement experience investigating crimes of white collar and contract fraud, environmental, federal/state program fraud, narcotics, racketeering and other violations of federal and state laws.

In this joint investigation, your affiants interviewed students, parents, teachers, support staff and others from Newpoint Pensacola, as well as ECSD employees.

As a result of this investigation, your Affiants have reason to believe and believe that on or about the period of January, 2013 to June, 2014, Christopher Fowler committed misdemeanor violations of Test Security Rules, Section 1008.24 (1) (c), F.S.

On June 21, 2011, the ESCD entered into a contract with 21<sup>st</sup> Century Academy of Pensacola, Inc., DBA as Newpoint Pensacola. Pursuant to the contract, Section 14.6 states the school shall administer such standardized assessments as required by state law. Under F.S. 1002.33, Charter School students shall, at a minimum, participate in the statewide assessment program created under F.S. 1008.22. Under this statue, section (3) (b) states "End-of-course" (EOC) assessments are conducted under the statewide, standardized assessment program.

On August 13, 2012, Chris Fowler was hired as a High School teacher at Newpoint Pensacola, certified as a math teacher by the Department of Education, State of Florida.

On April 14, 2015, your affiants interviewed Student #1, current  $12^{th}$  grade student, who stated during her Algebra I EOC, Chris Fowler, provided answers to her and other students while taking the state test. According to the student, Fowler would either whisper answers to students or use their mouse to point out the correct answer on the computer screen. In addition, the student stated that during the Geometry EOC, Fowler provided both equations and answers to her during the test. During her U.S. History EOC, the student stated Fowler provided answers to her during the test. According to the student, when she indicated she was confused with a question, Fowler would state to her " $\underline{B}$  (Be) good or B (Be) quiet" or "I can  $\underline{C}$  (see) why you are confused" as a way to provide answers to her.

The following is a synopsis of EOC test history referenced by Student #1:

Note: C. Fowler was not the assigned test administrator, but Student #1 reported that he came into the test room to provide her information.

On April 23, 2015, your affiants interviewed Student #2, a former student, who stated during the Geometry EOC, Fowler whispered answers to her.

The following is a synopsis of EOC test history referenced by Student #2:

On April 30, 2015, your affiants interviewed Student #3, current 11<sup>th</sup> grade student, who stated during his Algebra I EOC, Fowler provided answers to him. According to the student, Fowler would either give him a hand signal or simply give him the answer to questions that he was struggling to answer. In addition, the student also remembered Fowler stating the class (being tested) could not say anything about him helping or he (Fowler) could go to jail. The student also stated that during his Geometry EOC, Fowler would sit next to students and give answers. In addition, the student stated during his U.S. History EOC, Fowler used his personal cellular telephone to look up and provide answers to the entire group of students taking the test.

The following is a synopsis of EOC test history referenced by Student #3:

Based upon the aforementioned information, the Department of Education conducted a review of the EOC's administered at Newpoint Pensacola. Consequently, the review identified multiple anomalies which can be correlated by an examinee's answer string being extremely similar with that of another. This indicates answer copying, test coaching, proxy test taking, or some other form of collusion.

On April 6, 2015, your affiant Marsh delivered a letter from the Superintendent, ECSD, to Newpoint Pensacola, announcing a site visit to evaluate the operations and performance of the school. Later that day, Fowler resigned from his teaching position at Newpoint Pensacola.
