Hello Officer Worley,

Late Sunday evening/early yesterday morning, our swinging bench was stolen out of our neighborhood park (corner of Palafox and East Gonzalez Street). The bench was purchased by our neighborhood association. I have attached a photograph of the bench (it is on the top row, centered). It's approximately 6 feet wide and green. I have reported the theft to the Parks Department, and contacted Southern Scrap with the photo in case someone should try and scrap it. I just wanted to also let you know in case you or your officers see it anywhere while on patrols. We are devastated that this has occurred. I can't recall us ever having anything stolen out of our parks, much less a 300-pound bench. The adjacent business owner, Jacque LeBeau, is going to go through his security camera tapes this evening to see if his cameras captured any footage that would be helpful to your department.
