For weekend/holiday hours, staff will be working from home as needed. Friday 4/10/2020 is County holiday.</li> <li>-As of 11:00 am, 4/11/2020, the County has 206 positive COVID cases, 17 hospitalization, and 3 deaths.</li> <li>-Sacred Heart, Community Health, and Baptist Hospital has testing sites mobilized.</li> <li>-All testing sites require pre-screening phone call.</li> <li>-All government operations are working with limited public access, essential operations only, working by phone or internet. Work-from-home is being implemented on a limited basis where possible.</li> <li>-Limited feeding services are being provided in the community weekdays.</li> <li>-ESF 8 and Logistics working to fulfill medical supply needs through State Logistics.</li> <li>-CSA mobilized on 3/22/2020.
