Dear Azalea Trace Residents, Staff and Family Members,

Thank you all for your patience and support during his ongoing COVID-19 challenge. As we continue to provide weekly updates consistent with reporting requirements of the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), we want to keep you informed with the current situation at our community regarding Covid-19.

Over the past two weeks, Acts Retirement Life Communities has been working with each community within the Southeast Region to conduct COVID-19 testing for all residents and staff. The current round of testing was completed, and the results are coming in daily. To date, 8 residents and 5 employees have tested positive for COVID-19 in WillowBrooke Court. One resident is in the hospital, 5 are asymptomatic and 3 residents have mild symptoms. The employees are asymptomatic and are self-isolating at home. Any necessary treatment for employees is being provided offsite. Family members and representatives of residents whose test results are positive have been contacted.

Our community continues to implement extensive safety protocols to limit the spread of the virus. These collective efforts have been critical in protecting our residents and employees. These steps include resident health monitoring, implementation of appropriate isolation protocols, continuing restrictions on visitors and communal activities, daily employee screenings and temperature checks before each shift, appropriate use of personal protective equipment, and proper social distancing practices to limit personal contact.

We are well prepared to work through our current challenges and will continue to focus on testing and isolating any potential COVID-19 threat. As residents and employees, how we manage ourselves individually can influence the health and wellbeing of our community. Social distancing, hand washing and being cognizant of potential exposures to COVID-19 and taking necessary safeguards need to remain a part of every day. The safety of our residents and staff remains our utmost priority and we will continue to enforce precautionary protocols to protect our community.

Our goal is to continue taking steps forward and we must all work together to do so.
