I. THE CORE CONCEPT

Our vision is to transform 101 West Main Street from a traditional office space into a vibrant, ground-level destination that activates downtown Pensacola. As long-time residents and investors, we aim to create a space that is engaging, inclusive, and reflective of our city's unique sports identity.

Key Pillars of the Project:

- **Retail Excellence:** A flagship home for **Pensacola Blue Wahoos** merchandise.
- **Cross-Sport Celebration:** Featuring apparel and memorabilia from various local sports organizations.
- **The Memorabilia Vault:** A curated experience celebrating Pensacola's history of champions and legendary athletes.
- **Community Programming:** A venue for athlete appearances, youth sports events, and local cultural exhibits.

II. EXTERIOR TRANSFORMATION: "CHAMPION'S PLAZA"

The current exterior is functional but lacks the "street-level energy" required to drive downtown foot traffic. Our redesign focuses on turning the sidewalk into an invitation.

The Transformation:

- **Architectural Accents:** Replacing standard stucco with modern accents.
- **Interactive Sculptures:** Installation of oversized sports-themed art (baseballs, bats, and gloves) to create "Instagrammable" moments for visitors.

- **Outdoor Activation:** Expanded seating and railings to create an open, welcoming environment.
