for Permanent Restroom Facility at Veterans Memorial Park**

Pensacola, Florida — The Veterans Memorial Park Foundation is encouraged by recent discussions and commitments from the City of Pensacola regarding the long-awaited installation of permanent restroom facilities at Veterans Memorial Park.

Following a conversation with Mayor D.C. Reeves, the Foundation understands that the City is committed to moving forward with plans for a prefabricated four-stall permanent restroom facility to be installed in the area previously occupied by the temporary restroom trailer at the park.

This development marks a significant and much-needed step forward for the thousands of veterans, families, visitors, volunteers, and event attendees who utilize Veterans Memorial Park each year.

“For years, the Foundation and the veteran community have advocated for permanent restroom facilities that adequately serve the public while respecting the solemn and dignified character of Veterans Memorial Park,” said John Maddox, President of the Veterans Memorial Park Foundation. “What matters now is moving forward with a practical solution that can finally be completed and put into service for the veterans, families, and visitors who use the park every day.”
